## Answer: 2 Develops within 1 week of starting ESA therapy

Severe ESA resistance

Transfusion dependence

Very low reticulocyte count

Normal WBC/ Platelet counts

High S. Ferritin/ TSAT

Bone marrow showing virtual absence of red cell precursors

Develops approximately 2 months after ESA therapy

Presence of anti EPO antibodies

#### Question No: 2 The true statement about PARVO virus B 19 infection in a renal transplant patient is

## Ans: 2 : Respiratory system involvement is unusual

- Infection is acquired in general population as a droplet infection; but in KTR either donor derived or reactivation of latent infection
- Respiratory system involvement is uncommon
- Peaks at 2-3 months post transplant, majority in 1 year
- In KTR, incidence of Parvo virus related anemia is 1-2 %
